## Moving UAFM from GB to NI under the Northern Ireland Plant Health Label (NIPHL) scheme:

There are two options available for the movement of Used Agricultural and Forestry Machinery (UAFM) from GB to NI:

- The **NIPHL** scheme can be used where the **UAFM** is destined for NI. That is, it is intended for use by or sale to an end consumer in NI.
- Details on moving **UAFM** under the simplified **NIPHL** Scheme arrangements can be found on the **NIPHL Used Agricultural and Forestry Machinery page**.

Moving UAFM from GB through NI to the European Union (EU)/Ireland with a Phytosanitary Certificate:

- Where UFAM has a destination in the EU/Ireland, and is just transiting NI, full Official Controls Regulations (OCR) rules apply, and a valid Phytosanitary Certificate is required.
- Where UAFM is moved to NI for onward sale to EU/Ireland, full OCR rules apply, and a valid Phytosanitary Certificate is required.
- <u>Pre-Notification</u> of Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (DAERA) through submission of a <u>CHED-PP</u> part 1 into <u>TRACES NT</u> a minimum of 24 hours prior to arrival.
